#### Public Health Region & Dartmouth Hitchcock Community Health

- New Contracts with the State of New Hampshire
  - A new public health network contract with the State of NH went into effect on July 1, 2017. This contract provides support for our substance misuse continuum of care coordinator, the substance misuse prevention coordinator, and the emergency preparedness coordinator. Some funds in the contract may be available to support other projects that relate to our Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).
  - The contract is between the State of NH and Dartmouth-Hitchcock Community Health. The Public Health Council continues to serve as the "public health advisory council" required under the contract, though we have no direct contractual relationship with the state. Dartmouth-Hitchcock Community Health continues to provide some funding to the Public Health Council through other sources.
  - Dartmouth-Hitchcock Community Health now also holds the contract to support the Greater Sullivan County Public Health Region. This new relationship allows for a more efficient use of resources across the regions and increased collaboration.
