- Now in the process of submitting town funding requests for upcoming year, this income covers nearly 25% of the operational budget
  - o If anyone is interested in helping with petition drives or have ideas, please contact Alice
  - o 10/28 at Take Back Day in White River Junction Co-op might be a location
- Part of the strategic plan has been to increase the ability to support student interns in the region
  - If you know of organizations that need interns but do not have the organizational capacity to host them, please reach out to Alice
  - At DHMC Community Health, we often have this need and have partnered with PHC in the past and it has been effective
- As a reminder, November 17<sup>th</sup> will be the Annual Meeting

- We are halfway through this year of Community Flu Clinics
  - We have provided at least 750 vaccines so far
  - Opportunity for people 10+ to receive this flu vaccine for free

  - o Friday the 27<sup>th</sup> will be at the Mascoma Community Health Center 4-7 pm
  - o Saturday the 28<sup>th</sup> will be at the Windsor Welcome Center 10-1 pm
- Planning another bi-state legislative event
  - o November 6<sup>th</sup> at Dwinell Room on APD campus (by invitation on) 8:30-11:30 am
  - Focus of this event is workforce and how the following three topics impacts the ability to address the workforce crisis:
    - Housing (Andrew Winter and Clay Adams panelists)
    - Childcare (Shawn Mullholland and Joanne Roberts panelists)
    - Healthcare workforce pipeline and retention issues (AHEC and Vermont AHEC panelists)
  - o Add Peter, Ella, Brett to invitation list
- Asked for feedback on meeting format for 2024
  - People advocated for hybrid format
  - Like bringing the CHIP back to each meeting
  - Have presentations first and then end with introductions and partner updates

## 9:20 am - TLC Recovery Center, Dan Wargo, Program Manager (slides available)

- TLC started in Claremont and has expanded to Lebanon recently
- Drop-in area is for people utilizing the services
- Most staff have their CRSW
- Resource Navigation: someone is available during drop-in hours to help navigate resources
- Evidence-based programming during staff facilitated groups
- Lebanon site opened last week for soft opening
  - o Grand opening will be December 7th
  - o Please talk to Dan if you'd like to be on the invitation list

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- Question about funding and sustainability:
  - Initial funding to launch the Center was provided through the Opioid Abatement Grant through NH DHHS.
  - o This will provide sustainability for a few years
  - o Able to reimburse through Medicaid
  - Also supported through state of NH
- Located near the Lebanon Green
  - Accessible by the bus line
- Tri-County Cap is an organization to connect with
  - o Rebecca and Dan will connect

### 10:20 am - Partner Sharing & Discussion

- Good Neighbor Health Clinic's Lebanon location has several subspecialties
  - Call WRJ location for hours
  - Can serve people who are underinsured and not insured
- Families Flourish Northeast will have a 14-bed facility for pregnant and parenting moms seeking recovery on APD campus Homestead building in the future
- Divided Sky Foundation: purchased a location in Ludlow, VT with the hopes of being a treatment program. Have since backed away to be long-term supportive recovery housing
  - Hoping to open their doors on October 28<sup>th</sup>
  - They may come to talk about their services in the future
- APD has sandwich boards to give away- Alice will find out how any are available, contact her if
  you are interested in any
- City of Lebanon approved the purchase of 160 Mechanic Street (old High Meadow builders) to turn into a winter overnight shelter only
  - Slated to open in mid December
  - o Run by the Haven- just posted a job opening for shelter staff
  - 12 beds will be permanent with the ability to move 3 beds (15 total)
  - Dinner and breakfast will be served
  - Washer, dryer, shower will be available
  - Directly on the bus line
  - Will be connected with social services
- Project started in New London area around social connectedness in partnership with Kearsarge Neighborhood Partners
- DHMC Community Health:
  - DHMC Community Health have received six grant awards over the past few months to cover a variety of topics
  - In the process of designing the tools for the CHNA for the way we engage with community members
  - National Prescription Drug Take Back Day in October 28<sup>th</sup>. Local police departments are participating. ALL Together and Lebanon PD will be tabling at Hannaford in W Lebanon from 10-2 pm
  - o Holding a Getting to Y training to engage youth in prevention work
  - UV and GSCPHN's partnering with New Hampshire Charitable Foundation and New Futures to hold a Youth Advocacy event next Friday

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- On November 7<sup>th</sup>, Community Health is offering a Vaping 101 presentation to Mascoma community in partnership with Valley Court Diversion
- ALL Together and GSCPHN holding a NAMI NH Connect Suicide Prevention Gatekeeper training virtually on 11/8 from 9-11
- o ALL Together Partners meeting is October 25<sup>th</sup> at 2 pm, hybrid
- PHC has committee spots open
- Hartford Restorative Justice Center
  - House a number of people and bought a building
  - o 3 units that can hold 6 people- finishing upgrading the building
  - Planning to add on a gathering room and 2-3 studios
  - Give supportive services (do not have to be in the system) to people in public housing
